4. Findings, threshold status & corrective actions

Rodent pressure rising at dispatch (R-01) and canteen (R-11) — consumption >30% over baseline at R-01 triggers escalation. Added station; **recommend client seal the 8 mm gap under the north dispatch door** (exclusion — client responsibility).

German cockroach at action level in canteen (G-03) — gel re-applied; **recommend deep-clean of kitchen line under equipment** before next visit.

Stored-product insects below action level — continue monitoring.

Standing water observed near east perimeter after wash-down — **flag: mosquito breeding risk**, drain to be cleared.

5. Trend note (for audit file)

Rodent consumption trending up month-on-month at two points (dispatch + canteen) — consistent with a structural entry gap, not a bait failure. Escalation logged; re-check at next visit. All other indicators stable.
